

2007-2008 Team Championships

Withrow Football: Withrow won the first ever Cincinnati Metro Athletic Conference football league championship with a 6-0 record, 9-1 overall. The team qualified for the Division II state football playoffs hosting Archbishop Alter at the newly renovated Angus King Stadium. Senior Juandez Brown was voted CMAC Offensive Player of the Year and “Doc” Gamble was voted League Coach of the Year.

Hughes Volleyball: Earned a share of the CMAC league championship with a 12-2 record. Junior Jasmine Davis was voted First Team All League and Head Coach Anita Burke was voted CMAC Co-Coach of the Year.

Withrow Volleyball: Earned a share of the CMAC league championship with a 12-2 record. Juniors Alyssa Hall and Alexis Frazier were voted First Team All League and Head Coach Maria Seta was voted CMAC Co-Coach of the Year.

Withrow Boys Basketball: The Tigers finished the regular season as CMAC league champions with a record of 12-0 and 17-3 overall. Senior Yancy Gates was voted CMAC Player of the Year, First Team Enquirer Division I All City and State of Ohio Division I Player of the Year. Walt McBride was honored as CMAC Coach of the Year. The team advanced to the Division I “Elite Eight” for the second consecutive year by defeating Talawanda to win the District Championship and Oak Hills in the Regional semifinal.

Shroder Boys Basketball: The Boys Varsity Basketball Team, under the direction of Head Coach Thomas Owens, finished the regular season with a record of 4-16 and then went on an incredible run in the Division III State Tournament defeating Madeira, Clark Montessori and Deer Park on their way to defeating Hamilton Badin at the University of Dayton to win the District Championship and qualifying for the D-III “Sweet Sixteen”. The Jaguars lost a close one to Columbus Academy in the Regional Semi-Finals at Wright State University.

Woodward Girls Basketball: The Woodward Girls Varsity Basketball Team won the CMAC League Championship with a record of 11-1 and 17-3 overall. Senior Amber Torrey was voted First Team All League and Andrew Schroer was voted CMAC Coach of the Year.

CMAC Quiz Team: Withrow finished the regular season with a match play record of 10-2 finishing just ahead of Hughes Center who had a record of 9-3. Taft finished third with a match play record of 7-5.

Western Hills Wrestling: Jacob Hargis (135 lbs.), Clifford Peter (140 lbs.), Jacob West (152 lbs.), Kevin Kelley (160 lbs.), Charles Dove (171 lbs.), Charles Cummins (189 lbs.) and Klark Klayman (285 lbs.) won individual championships at the Cincinnati Metro Athletic Conference League Wrestling Tournament. George Williams was voted CMAC Coach of the Year.

Western Hills Baseball: Finished the CMAC season in first place with a record of 8-2. Jordan Walker, James Pierson and Zach Norman were voted First Team All League.

Withrow Softball: Finished the CMAC season in first place with a record of 7-2. Jasmine McQueen and Tonisha Carter were voted First Team All League. Coach Robert Burns was voted CMAC Softball Coach of the Year.

CMAC Track and Field Relays: The Withrow Girls finished first in the CMAC Relays Meet with 119 points over Taft who finished second with 48 points and Hughes Center finishing third with 38 points. The Withrow Boys finished first with 83 points to 73 points for second place Western Hills and third place Shroder with 48 points.

The Withrow Boys finished first with 204 points to 92 points for second place Western Hills and third place Shroder who had 87 points.
