

2010-2011 Team Highlights

Taft Football: Taft won the Cincinnati Metro Athletic Conference football league championship with a 6-0 league record, finishing the season 7-3 overall. Junior Dwayne Stanford was voted CMAC Offensive Player of the Year. Junior Adolphus Washington was voted CMAC Defensive Player of the Year as well as All Ohio Division IV Defensive Player of the Year. Mike Martin was voted CMAC Coach of the Year and All Ohio Division IV Coach of the Year. Taft qualified for the State Division IV playoffs and lost to top ranked Clinton Massie 21-20 in overtime.

Hughes and Woodward Football: The National High School Football Records Book has certified the Hughes vs. Woodward football rivalry as the second oldest continuing high school football rivalry in the United States. The two teams met for the first time in 1878 and 2010 was the 114th time the two teams have played each other in that span of 122 years.

Hughes Volleyball: Won the CMAC league championship with a 13-1 record finishing the season with an overall record of 13-7. Skyler Willis from Withrow was voted CMAC Player of the Year and Withrow Head Coach Karen Dewar was voted CMAC Coach of the Year.

Taft Boys Basketball: The Senators finished the regular season as CMAC league champions with a record of 12-1 and 19-1 overall. Mark Mitchell was honored as CMAC Coach of the Year. The Senators won Sectional, District and Regional Championships advancing to Division III Final Four. The Senator broke or tied five team tournament records including tying the record for the largest margin of victory in a championship game when they defeated Cleveland Central Catholic 95-52. It was the first state basketball championship in the school's history and the first for a CPS team since Woodward captured the Division I title in 1988. Junior Adolphus Washington was recognized as the All Ohio Division III Co-Player of the Year.

Hughes Girls Basketball: The Hughes Girls Varsity Basketball Team shared the CMAC League Championship with Withrow H.S. with a record of 11-1 and 15-5 overall. Junior Almesha Jones was voted CMAC Player of the Year and Anita Burke was voted CMAC Coach of the Year.

Withrow Girls Basketball: The Withrow Girls Varsity Basketball Team shared the CMAC League Championship with Hughes H.S. with a record of 11-1 and 16-4 overall.

CMAC Academic Team: Woodward won the Cincinnati Metro Athletic Conference Academic Team Championship finishing the regular season with a match play record of 8-0.

Withrow Wrestling: Ricky Underwood (112 lbs.), Chris Tombs (135 lbs.), B.J. Adams (140 lbs.), Greg Collins (152 lbs.), Iva Durand III (171 lbs.), Nicholas Isaacs (189 lbs.), Mouhamed Wade (215 lbs.) and Brandon Mitchell (285 lbs.) won individual championships at the Southwest Ohio Wrestling Classic Tournament hosted by Thurgood Marshall H.S. Withrow scored 274 points good for first place ahead of Western Hills with 170 points and Western Hills with 163 points. Brandon Mitchell was voted Wrestler of the Year Clinton McElroy was voted Wrestling Coach of the Year.

Western Hills Baseball: The Mustangs shared the CMAC title with Withrow with a league record of 8-2.

Withrow Baseball: The Tigers shared the CMAC title with Western Hills with a league record of 8-2. Rodeney Spaulding was selected as CMAC Coach of the Year.

Withrow Softball: The Lady Tigers finished the CMAC season undefeated and in first place with a record of 8-0-1. First year Head Coach Angel Archer was voted CMAC Coach of the Year.

CMAC Track and Field Relays: The Withrow Girls finished first in the CMAC Relays Meet with 116 points over Shroder who finished second with 62 points and Aiken in third place with 52 points. The Withrow Boys finished first with 113 points to 99 points for second place Western Hills and 79 points for third place Shroder.

The Withrow Girls finished first in the 2011 CMAC Track & Field Championship Meet with 242 points over Shroder who finished second with 83 points and Aiken finished third with 69 points.
