

2012-2013 TEAM HIGHLIGHTS

Withrow Football: Withrow won the Cincinnati Metro Athletic Conference football league championship with a 6-0 league record, finishing the season 7-3 overall. Senior Nick Isaacs was voted CMAC Defensive Player of the Year. Jim Place was voted CMAC Coach of the Year.

Hughes Volleyball: Won the CMAC league championship with a league record of 10-2. Jayla Smith from Withrow was voted CMAC Player of the Year and Withrow Head Coach Dennis Ullery was voted CMAC Coach of the Year.

Hughes Boys Basketball: The Big Red finished the regular season as CMAC league co-champions with a league record of 10-2. The team has a season record of 17.5.
